How did I overcome my doubts to get vaccinated?

- Initially, I was sceptical about the safety and efficacy of the COVID-19 vaccine
- However, many of my colleagues abroad were vaccinated and they reported no major side effects were reported.

The Experience

- On the day of the vaccination (Tuesday 9th March 2021), I arrived at the MTRH vaccination centre, registered, assessed (eligibility), consented.
- **VACCINATED** with Oxford-AstraZeneca under the (COVISHIELD-Recombinant) at MTRH
- Given in Scheduled phases –1st and second dose 8 weeks apart

Experience cont'd

- The vaccination process was smooth -did not face any challenges
- Received a vaccination certificate and acknowledgement SMS of my first vaccination along with the information regarding my second vaccination

Advance Events following Immunization

- Experienced no side effect for 15 minutes while on observation at the vaccination centre
- I didn't experience any events after the vaccination, just tenderness (mild pain) at the site of injection
